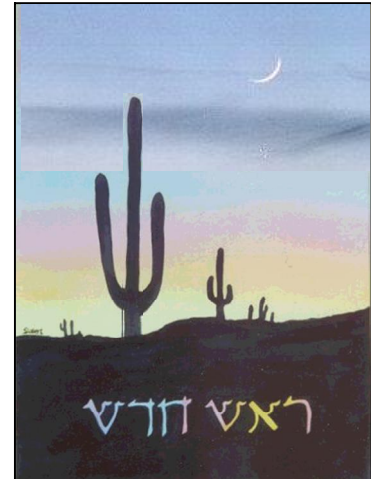


RESTORING YHWH'S "ROSH CHADASH"-NEW MOON CALENDAR! For the Roman Solar Year: 2010 c.e.



Learn to make your own New Moon (Rosh Chodesh) calendar based upon the Moon/Sun set times found in any Farmer's Almanac. You can obey this Law without having to depend on others to know WHEN to sight YHWH's New Moons. So, be self sufficient in obeying YHWH's Laws and Feast Days. It will make His Laws more meaningful and personal for you - and more enjoyable! You can learn these things and teach others YHWH's Way! We also blow the shofar as instructed (Numbers 10:10) as you are dressed in His "Garments of Salvation". More people are learning of the New Moon. Use the "New Moon Report" on our website to see who else around the country has also sighted it!

YHWH'S NEW YEAR (Rosh h'Shanah) BEGINS IN THE SPRING (Ex. 9:31; 12:2; 13:4; 34:18; Deut.16:1)



The green ears of barley (Abib) should be spotted in the Spring around Yerushalem during the Roman month of March before it's time to sight the New Moon. (We depend on the following website to confirm this sighting <http://www.karaite-korner.org/abib> Upon this confirmation of the Abib barley, the following New Moon sighting marks the New Year (Rosh h'Shanah) of YHWH and the first Hebrew month "Abib".

In order to understand and make your own New Moon calendar, purchase a Farmer's Almanac at the bookstore or go to the internet website: <http://www.almanac.com/rise>. Find the section with moonset and sunset times for each roman month. The lunar cycle is 29-1/2 days. (The day will come when we can't obtain a Farmer's Almanac, we will simply count off 29-1/2 days and be ready to watch for the New Moon again.) The almanac gives the date of the "black" moon which is a full conjunction used by the Jews (This is why the Jews always keep "their" feasts at least a day too early. (They live by their Talmud – or rabincal tradition.) See Isayah 1:14) This "black moon" cannot be seen with the naked eye! The Almanac erroneously calls THIS date the "New Moon" – **but this is NOT YHWH's "New Moon"!** However, this is the BEST DATE to BEGIN determining WHEN the New Moon crescent will appear on the western horizon. There's NO New Month until the crescent can be witnessed with the naked eye!!! Here are instructions for determining with accuracy YHWH's rosh chodesh.

1. Using the Farmer's Almanac, find the sunset & the moonset time for that "black moon. Notice that the sun and moon set times are nearly the same. The NEW MOON cannot be spotted on this night because the moon is under *full* shadow. Write down and compare the sunset time and the moon set times for the next evening. When the moon set time is LESS than 35 minutes after the sunset time, you will NOT SEE the New Moon with the naked eye - it's too low - too thin - and it's still too bright on the horizon. When the moon set time is MORE than 35 minutes after sunset time, then you must go outside and try to spot this thin crescent. Under clear conditions, someone – somewhere will be able to spot the New Moon crescent, usually those in arid climates.

2. Go to the next day's sunset and moonset times. The moonset time will progress later in the evening increasing 50-70 minutes more than the night before. Write down your sunset times and moonset times for at least 2 -3 days beginning with the black moon date. Take the difference in sunset and moon set times and you have how many minutes the MOON is up! If you calculate the New Moon to be up for 60 minutes - you will surely see it! If you calculate the New Moon to be up for 35 minutes - you might see it - you should, but sky conditions have to be PERFECT. Always spot the New Moon on the western horizon on that night – dependent on sky conditions, etc. It will be 12.2 degrees higher in the sky than the previous evening. As the moon sets, the sky gets darker and makes the New Moon shine brighter - like "a polished sword" – another meaning for "chodesh". 3. Find the New Moon for each month of the year in the Farmer's Almanac. It's easy! Then, Blow the shofar and celebrate YHWH's appointed Feasts according to His ordained time piece in the sky – the Rosh Chodesh New Moon! YHWH's Feasts are set according to this clock and no other! HalleluYah! YHWH's Feasts of 2009 should take place on the following Roman dates:

Yahsha's Memorial (the night before Passover)
Passover (Pesach) and Feast of Unleavened Bread
Pentecost (Shabuot)
The Day of Trumpet Blasts (Yom Teruah)
The Day of National Forgiveness (Yom Kippur)
The Feast of Tabernacles (Succot) & Last Great Day

After sunset roman june 17th
After sunset roman october 9th
After sunset roman october 18th
After sunset roman october 23rd thru 30th
